Albanie (AL): Les chiffres concernent l'année scolaire 2019-2020
Belgique francophone et germanophone (BE-FR): Les chiffres pour l'enseignement fondamental concernent l'année 2019-2020; ceux du secondaire 2020-2021. Sur un total de 285 écoles secondaires, 28 écoles proposent seulement de l'enseignement inférieur (3 premières années), tandis que 4 écoles ne
Belgique néerlandophone (BE-NL): Les chiffres concernent l'année scolaire 2019-2020
Royaume-Uni (Angleterre et Pays de Galles): School totals: I have entered our 405 secondary schools under 'lower secondary' although 286 (71%) of these are 11-18, and the rest are 11-16. Under 'higher secondary' I have entered our 15 'sixth-form colleges' which are 16-19 years. Please note that we have 51 'all-through' (3-19) schools - these have been entered into both primary and secondary totals, but this 'double counting' has been eliminated in the total of pedagogical entities. Most of our primary schools have a nursery, taking pupils from 2 or 3 years old. There are also separate nurseries provided by parishes or Catholic charities, but these are not classified as schools, and are not included in our census or these figures. Pupil totals: I have entered all Y7-11 (11-16) pupils under 'lower secondary' and all Y12-14 (16-19) pupils under 'higher secondary' regardless of whether they are in a school or a sixth-form college. Most of our schools are fully state-funded, but 114 schools (5%) with 37,921 pupils (4%) are funded by parental fees.
Royaume-Uni (Ecosse): Scotland does not have lower/higher secondary schools they are one phase in education. There are no Catholic nurseries, although some of our Catholic primary schools have nurseries attached, by law these have to be non denominational. 360 of our schools are owned, managed and run by the Local Government Authority - these are all free of charge to parents. 3 are Independent/Private/Fee paying schools.
